# This week's reflection.

Mary, a young peasant woman, journeyed on foot over rugged territory for days to visit he cousin Elizabeth. The encounter of these two mothers-to-be –Mary and Elizabeth— is one of much love and joy.

What makes this so powerful is that Mary and Elizabeth choose to be joyful, despite the chaos around them. It is a story of hope and a lesson for us that we must be people of hope for others. Hope enables us to see over our present problems to future possibilities.

Pope Francis said: `Hope is what Mary, mother of God sheltered in her heart during the darkest time in her life, Good Friday afternoon to Easter Sunday morning. That is hope: Mary had it and that hope has renewed everything.'

Every year we have Advent to remember and delight in, that the Incarnation is the reality that God has become one of us in the person of Jesus. God's love for us is given freely and without condition. We are treasured beyond measure.

This Advent/Christmas season, may we become agents of peace and justice, of encouragement, forgiveness, hope and light for all those we encounter.

### Parish improvements

You may have noticed that there has been changes when entering and exiting the parish office. This improvement allows staff, priests and volunteers to work safely and securely at all times of the day.

#### **TO ENTER** the parish office during office hours:

- PRESS the silver button that says 'press here' located to the LEFT of the screen door.
- 2. This will alert a staff member you are at the door. When you hear a voice telling you that 'The door is open'
- TURN the screen door handle to enter. 3.

#### When LEAVING the parish office:

- PRESS the blue button located to the LEFT of the door.
- 2. This will release the screen door.
- 3. TURN the screen door handle to exit.
