The Glory of the Mountain and the Call to the Valley

The Transfiguration of Jesus is a powerful revelation of His divine nature, as Peter, James, and John behold Him in dazzling glory. This moment on the mountain is one of awe and wonder, a glimpse of the heavenly reality that awaits those who follow Christ. Yet, as overwhelming as this encounter is, Jesus does not allow His disciples to remain there. Instead, He leads them back down the mountain—back into the world of suffering, struggle, and faith lived out in daily life.

This is a reminder for all of us. Our faith is not meant to be lived only in extraordinary spiritual highs but also in the ordinary and difficult moments of life. St. Augustine tells us to set our hearts on things above, but our mission is here on earth. As St. John Henry Newman reminds us, we each have a purpose that God has given us—a service to carry out in His name.

The disciples carried the memory of glory with them, strengthening them for the trials ahead. In the same way, our encounters with God in prayer and worship equip us to bring His light to others. St. Teresa of Avila's words challenge us: "Christ has no body now on earth but yours." We are called to be His hands and feet in the world, bringing His love and truth where they are most needed.



As we reflect on the Transfiguration, let us embrace both the moments of glory and the journey down the mountain, knowing that Christ walks with us in both.



A Securer Parish

At the beginning of February, we moved midweek Mass into the St George Preca Centre to update the security system in the church. This was the last building to have this work completed.

We are very pleased to announce that all 3 parish buildings have an enhanced security system, providing protection to the buildings and their people. The new system will allow flexibility in operating and securing our parish.

So, what has been done...

- Upgraded the old existing alarm systems in the Church and St George Preca Centre with a new system that is in line with the parish office system.
- 2. Upgraded old sensors in the Church and St George Preca Centre
- 3. Installed additional sensors in the Parish Office and St George Preca Centre
- Installed an intercom system with a secured entry point to the reception area of the parish office
- 5. Installed a secured locking system to the chapel external door
- Installed external cameras on the parish office and St George Preca Centre.
- Installed internal cameras in the church and chapel

Funding for this project has been provided by the NSW Government.

We give thanks for this Government grant and by next week will announce new extended hours for the chapel to be open.
