Hope in a Barren Place

Nicole was a professional dancer whose dancing was her outlet for trauma she had experienced growing up. While teaching a dance lesson, she ruptured her hamstring. Her career was in tatters. Her one coping mechanism was gone, her future seemed over, and she reacted by pushing away those closest to her, becoming anxious and depressed.

The Gospel we hear this weekend, relates stories of victims encountering forces beyond their control. Why do these terrible things happen? Their despair echoes that of Nicole, and of any of us who have experienced grief, depression, anxiety and pain which seems to have no end. Jesus responds first by recognising that there is no escape from the reality of suffering and death. We will all perish in this life. But it is not because some people deserve it, and we are not being punished by an angry God.

Jesus does not leave us with the finality of darkness, but says the way forward is to repent. Repentance is linked with the Greek word, *metanoia*, a total change of heart and mind. Jesus is inviting us to radically reorientate ourselves from a space where only darkness and barrenness consumes us. The Gospel's fig tree is in a barren place, bearing no fruit for years, and there is no escape except to be cut down. Yet the one who tends the vineyard, representing God, asks for one more year. God aches for our healing, for our wholeness, and gently digs around the garden of our heart. Even when we stop hoping, God continues to believe and hope in us, as do those who are close to us, and the broader community.

One sign of hope is the mental health organisation, Beyond Blue, offering support to Australians. This is also where Nicole's story can be found (see beyondblue.org.au). Nicole's partner gently encouraged her to find help. She had the courage to share her dark place with her GP who offered no judgement but only pathways of healing. These included finding ways to share her experience with those closest to her so they could support her better. She has since cultivated many



lifegiving approaches, and when some days are overwhelming she allows herself to stop and experience the emotions, and recognise there are just days where she doesn't feel great. God continues to nourish the soil around our heart, and invites us to gently and courageously repent, to seek new ways of seeing, feeling, thinking, and believing, so we may be open to the breath of goodness this world offers.


