PROMISING BIG STEPS – and a CHURCH 50th BIRTHDAY GIFT

Dear friends,

A year ago in 2024, an extensive report was prepared and presented to parishioners concerning the assets of OLQP parish. And many parishioners then responded to a parish consultation survey, which has guided hundreds of hours of planning, research and negotiation since. The short version of some excellent news is: New pathways have now been found to repair, reorganise and renew some seriously expensive needs for our church, buildings and parish property.

Faithfulness – Generosity – AND accumulated costs

For so many years this parish has been faithful to God in its funding of pastoral outreach, missionary support and making a difference in many people's lives. Also, decisions in the 1990s and early 2000s about parish property use enhanced our cherished schools, enabling a large school hall, extension primary school recreation space and teacher parking. This was done through the generous giving up of ongoing parish income potential from the north facing land down Old Prospect Road. As well back then, the parish sold its other land (now the site of Genista Aged Care), to pay parish costs and renovations and to contribute to the school hall. The reality since has been a yearly 'break-even', faithfully covering core costs and mission priorities, but not covering the hugely accumulating building and property repairs.







Big problems – and big pathways to solve them

To meet such costs we wouldn't be able to service the loans needed and the challenge to sustain things now and for the future has accumulated to become very big! I'm so thankful, however, to now be able to say that the path ahead is also now looking promisingly possible and big.

The childcare development in our parish-owned building on the Braeside Rd corner is a new step about to serve families from 2026. But it's only the first good step of what's unfolding ahead.

In this year of 2025, the OLQP parish church is 50 years of age. It had repairs and renewal around the 20 year mark and now has scary repair costs waiting in its roof, walls, windows, electrics, plumbing and floor. Due to new plans unfolding, however, we will be able to do this AND also beautify the front and surrounds AND give it solar powered air conditioning. It won't happen overnight but the new plans mean that it will happen AND it will be paid.

Very good news - and best news?

Please pray for some important next important steps of property planning and negotiating that are going on right now. Hopefully by Sunday 23rd November (or otherwise 7th December), we'll be able to present a very good news plan to explain the approach that's making it look very possible to repair, renew and sustain the parish buildings and property for now and the future. It's a plan to pull together every component that was in that major report and parish consultation a year ago. It goes further than anticipated a year ago and it looks like doing so without the parish needing to carry any big debts. In my mind, that's the best news!


Not to take it easy!
