The DEDICATION of the LATERAN BASILICA

Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica: Our Hearts, God's Temple

his Sunday, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica—the oldest Christian church in the world and the first permanent home of worship for Christians. Built by Emperor Constantine after centuries of persecution, this Basilica stands as a living testament to the courage, faith, and love of early Christians who refused to abandon Christ, even under threat of death. It reminds us that the Church is not just bricks and stone; it is the faithful hearts of those who love God.

Across the square stands a statue of St. Francis of Assisi, arms wide, as if embracing the world. Centuries ago, he came here to meet the Pope, asking permission to start his religious order. Inspired by Christ's words, "Rebuild my Church," he humbly entrusted the mission of renewal to the Holy Father. From one angle, the Basilica appears perfectly framed between St. Francis' outstretched arms—as if the saint himself were holding up the Church. This striking image shows us that the Church thrives not through architecture alone, but through the devotion, courage, and love of the faithful.

Yet the greatest temple of God is not made of stone. Each of us is called to be a living temple of the Holy Spirit. This Sunday's Gospel tells of Jesus cleansing the Jerusalem Temple. Just as the Temple required purification, so too must our hearts. Ask yourself: Is my heart free from anger, jealousy, or selfishness? Do I nurture love, forgiveness, and faith? Am I open to the Spirit, allowing Christ to dwell fully within me? Purifying our hearts is not a single act; it is a daily commitment, a choice to let God transform us from the inside out.



The Feast of the Lateran Basilica invites us to rekindle our zeal for God and His Church. Loving the Church begins with loving God in our hearts. When we purify our intentions, thoughts, and relationships, we create living spaces for Christ to dwell. We uphold the Church not only through prayer and service but by witnessing His love in every encounter, every act of mercy, every word of encouragement.

Life brings trials. The Church faces challenges, even scandals, that can test our faith. Yet God's promise never fails: He is always with us. Through His grace, He purifies and strengthens our hearts, helping us persevere in faith, hope, and love. As living temples, our hearts support the Church, sustain her mission, and bear witness to Christ's enduring presence in the world.

On this Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, let us reflect on our hearts as temples of the Spirit. May the Lord purify, strengthen, and fill us with His love. Let us renew our commitment to Him and His Church. With faith, prayer, and devotion, we hold up the Church. In doing so, our hearts become living sanctuaries where God's glory shines brightly, radiating His love to all who encounter us.
