

Finding Joy in the Journey of Faith

Reflections for Gaudete Sunday – Rejoice, for the Lord is Near

A few years ago, a friend went through a time when he doubted everything about his Faith. He felt lost, confused, and even frustrated. One day, someone reminded him that even John the Baptist—who had known Jesus personally—had questions and moments of doubt. That simple reminder brought him hope: if John could survive a crisis of Faith, so could he.

This Third Sunday of Advent, *Gaudete Sunday*, gives us that same message. John’s moment of doubt teaches us an important lesson: **it’s normal to struggle in our Faith**. Even the strongest believers may encounter moments of confusion, discouragement, or disillusionment. These experiences, though difficult, can help us grow stronger. Faith isn’t just about believing everything perfectly; it’s about trusting Jesus even when we have questions. In moments of doubt, we are called to deepen our understanding of the Faith, to pray, and to trust that God can strengthen and renew us.

Jesus also tells John’s disciples: “Go and tell others what you hear and see.” This reminds us that God’s love, mercy, and forgiveness are gifts meant to be shared. Advent is a season of preparation and joy, a time to notice how Christ is working in our lives. Our joy grows when we share it with family, friends, and neighbours. Small acts of kindness, patience, and forgiveness are ways of proclaiming Christ to the world. Even in ordinary life, we can become signs of God’s love for others.

Today’s readings also invite us to **open our hearts and let God transform us**. Advent calls us to make room for Jesus in our lives. If we live with ourselves at the centre, life can feel frustrating, lonely, or empty. But if we allow Christ to be at the centre, everything changes. God wants to transform our hearts, minds, and actions toward love, compassion, and service. Advent is a time for metanoia—a turning of our thoughts and lives toward God, others, and ourselves.

Finally, we are called to **be more than prophets**—to be Christ’s presence in the world. St. Teresa of Avila said it beautifully: “Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which Christ’s compassion looks out to the world. Yours are the feet by which He goes about doing good. Yours are the hands by which He blesses us now.” Each of us is invited to become Christ’s voice, hands, and heart in our homes, workplaces, and communities.

This Gaudete Sunday, let us rejoice! Even in times of doubt, God is near. Even in small acts of love, Christ is present. And even in our ordinary lives, He wants to transform us and use us to bring His light to others.

Practical Takeaway: This week, notice one way God is at work in your life and share it with someone else. Let your actions, words, or prayers be a simple sign of Christ’s love to others.






