Seeing Beyond the Horizon, Following Jesus in the New Year!

As the Church begins a new liturgical year, today's Gospel from Matthew invites us to reflect on the call of discipleship and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near," He proclaims, and immediately He begins to call His first followers, Simon Peter and Andrew, James and John, to leave their nets and follow Him. These early moments reveal a profound truth: following Jesus requires courage, vision, and a willingness to step into the unknown.

A story that captures this beautifully comes from an old Indian chief. On his deathbed, he summoned his three sons and asked them to climb the holy mountain and bring back something of beauty. The first returned with a rare, delicate flower; the second with a polished, colourful stone. The third returned empty-handed. "Father," he said, "I have brought nothing. But from the peak, I saw on the far side a land of green pastures and a crystal lake. I glimpsed a better future for our tribe, and I was so overwhelmed by the vision that I returned with nothing else." The chief declared him the new leader, for he had brought the most precious gift of all—a vision for the future.

In many ways, this mirrors the call of the first disciples. Jesus invites them to leave the familiar shores of Galilee, the safety of their nets and boats, and follow Him into a life filled with purpose and vision. Like the son who saw beyond the mountain, they are invited not merely to witness miracles, but to envision a world transformed by God's kingdom. Their courage and openness allowed them to see possibilities beyond the horizon and embrace a new future.

As we plan for the months ahead, may we, like the disciples, be attentive to God's invitation to leave our comfort zones and embrace the vision He has for our lives. May we have eyes to see the new possibilities, hearts willing to respond, and hands ready to act for the kingdom of heaven here and now.

When should I complete my Safeguarding Training?

All Clergy, employees and volunteers in parish ministry are required by the NSW Children's Guardian Act 2019 to be current and complete with Safeguarding Training. Check with your Parish Office when you are due to update your Safeguarding Training.

- If you are new to ministry, you must complete the Introductory Modules 1-3 (Cycle 1).
- If you completed Cycle 1 modules two years ago, you must complete Renewal Modules 4 and 5 (Cycle 2)
- If you renewed your Cycle 2 two years ago, you must complete a Refresher Module 6 (Cycle 3)


