


-Fr Paul to remote north India - plus -Parish Plan for Youth needs Parent Food Volunteers

India Mission and Fr Paul

Dear friends – The following is a brief background to my next two weeks of mission absence in India: Through some coincidences, my first visit to India in 1986 led some years later to what's now been a 25 year mission involvement in the far north east of that country, up into the lower Himalayan Mountains. It's in the diocese of Darjeeling, described in various information searches as a 'frontier diocese' and one of the Catholic Church's most remote dioceses in the world. I can't sum up quickly the privilege it's been - and is - to be so closely associated there; in particular with a large and extended local family from a mountain village called Pedong in the eastern Himalayas. With some inspiring members of this family I've pursued different mission projects in response to specific needs. Key among these are two schools we built, started and grew - that they continue to operate; a high school (St Francis of Assisi in Gorubathan) and a pre-kindergarten to Year 5 (Sacred Heart School in Pedong).

We as Catholic Christians believe that our involvement in 'mission' can be here in our local home, street, parish or community – or across the city, nation or world. And just like some of our parish SRE Catechists who go into the local government schools have told us; they started out by wanting to do good and share faith – but were then surprised by how much the mission moved them, changed them, stretched them and grew their own faith! From a Catholic understanding, that's one of the hallmark differences that makes something not 'charity' or just our work – but 'mission' – 'God's mission'. God's mission changes us – as we seek, through various works, to build the kingdom on earth with others! I trust that this next short 'mission' trip over the coming two weeks will keep changing me; that it will move and stretch me again – and in some surprise way of God's grace enrich how my vocation might then better serve back here at home.

My prayers will be in union with you all while I'm gone. God bless – Fr Paul

Parish Youth – new structure – Parent food volunteers needed

- The basic structure will be / Eat and Social / Brief Life-Faith input (with a take-home motivation) / Games - Activity - Social
- Periodic other events offered between the 1st Sundays





When should I complete my Safeguarding Training?

All Clergy, employees and volunteers in parish ministry are required by the NSW Children's Guardian Act 2019 to be current and complete with Safeguarding Training. Check with your Parish Office when you are due to update your Safeguarding Training.

- If you are new to ministry, you must complete the Introductory Modules 1-3 (Cycle 1).
- If you completed Cycle 1 modules two years ago, you must complete Renewal Modules 4 and 5 (Cycle 2)
- If you renewed your Cycle 2 two years ago, you must complete a Refresher Module 6 (Cycle 3)
